## ROSÉ DE FRANCE 2018

Classification: Vin de France

Vineyards: South of France, Languedoc

Terroir: high-lying, with cool temperatures, nearing the Med. Sea

Viticulture: sustainable

Vintage: 2018

Grapes: Grenache (50%) and Cinsault (50%)

As we head into beautiful summer weather, there's no better way to celebrate than to be outside. And, while it's great to celebrate and raise a glass on your own, why not invite family and friends over to join in the fun of a Garden Party?

This idea was our guide line when Bruno produced this wine full of sunshine flavors and fragrant Mediterranean scents.

This beautiful pale-pink color blend of Grenache and Cinsault is a refreshing and well-balanced rosé. It offers a gorgeous mélange of upfront citrus, bright spring flowers and strawberry aromas that are framed by hints of crisp mouthwatering saline notes, finishing snappy and fresh.

Traditional winemaking process in stainless vessels with careful temperature control to protect the natural fruit flavors, typical of both varieties. Direct pressing and stalk removal at 5°C.

Enjoy a glass sat out in the sun, with light salads, pasta and rice dishes, especially with seafood, raw and lightly cooked shellfish and grilled fish and goats' cheeses. Perfect hot weather drinking.
